Libby, Chair of the Duck Race, gave a huge THANK YOU to everyone that helped out in any way with this year's Duck Race. The super effort of the Committee and other helpers produced the best-ever sales of over \$90,000 in ticket sales plus revenue from the games and sponsors.

Short Term Exchange Program (STEP)

Sharon Kyle gave an update on our STEP students. Our two outgoing students are **Melanie Pellicano** and **Breeanna Myden**. Under this program, our out-going students stay with the parents of the student from the foreign country, who in turn stay with the parents of our outgoing students.

(Melanie and Helloise both attended our Club on July 25.) Breanna Myden left for France on August 15, 2023 and her exchange student from France is Charlotte Basso, who is staying with Breanna's parents.

Ineke reported that the garage sale that was held in the parking lot of the Hospice Thrift Store on Saturday August 12 (the day before the Duck Race) went very well, with almost \$600 in revenue. The remaining unsold items were donated to the Hospice Thrift Store and to Value Village.
