If there are any objections with any of the following persons joining our Club, please contact President Brian Bekar or myself, within 10 days of the date of this circulation notice.

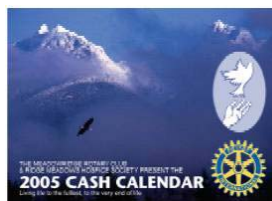
