Program:

Andrea Madden, Executive Director of our Chamber of Commerce

Andrea Madden has been the executive director of our Chamber of Commerce for the past three years, and for three years prior to that worked for the Chamber of Commerce of the Tri-Cities area. And for 14 years before that lived and worked in Singapore.



The Maple Ridge, Pitt Meadows and Mission Chambers have teamed up with Bestway Tours and Safaris to offer an 11

day guided tour to India, to be held from September 24 to October 4, 2017. The tour will explore India's "Golden Triangle" (Delhi, Agra and Jaipur), the Rathambore National Tiger Reserve and eight UNESCO world heritage sites.

The total price for the package, including airfare, is only \$2,895 for members of the Chamber, but non-members are welcome for the additional amount of only \$200. The single supplement is \$450, \$750 is due at booking, with full payment by June 30, 2017. Price includes not only return airfare, but also all taxes and airline surcharges, deluxe hotel accommodation, eight breakfasts, two lunches and four dinners, entrance fees to museums and monuments, air-conditioned transportation for all sightseeing and transfers, English-speaking tour guide in India, bottled water during sightseeing, rickshaw ride in Delhi, elephant ride at Amber Fort in Jaipur, and two Jeep safaris in the Rathambore National Park.
