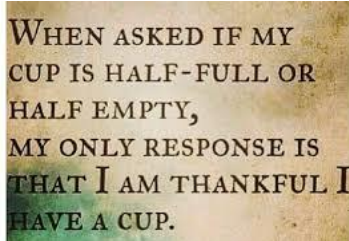

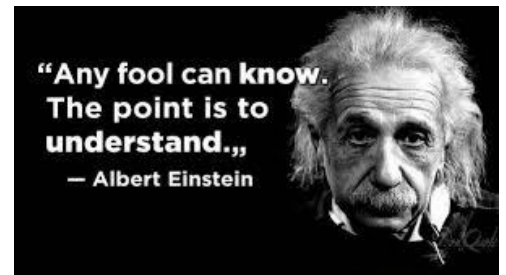

Clint owns Callison Financial Services Limited, in conjunction with Co-operators Insurance.

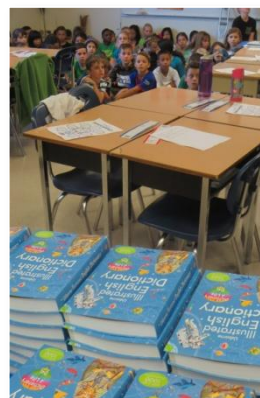
