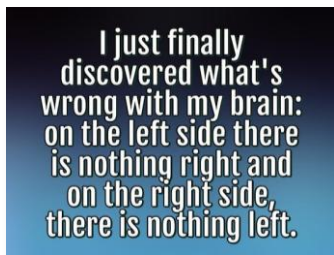

Speakers: Campbell and Green – the wandering minstrels

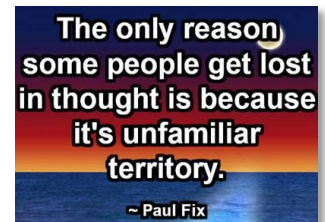
