Cheque Presentation #1:



About Youth Unlimited:

In 2002, YFC Youth Unlimited opened its Maple Ridge division. A faith-based youth organization with a mandate to work in the public setting, Youth Unlimited Greater Vancouver runs many different programs including drop in centres, skate board clubs, teen mom programs, prevention and education, and many others that commit to seeing teens become whole.

Specifically focused on marginalized, vulnerable teens, Youth Unlimited walked into the Maple Ridge community knowing that the



Dennis Hemminger, Maple Ridge Area Supervisor for Youth Unlimited, has been with the organization for 15 years. Youth Unlimited began outreach in the school system and one thing they heard time and again was that kids were coming to school hungry. They didn't have the means to obtain breakfast and sometimes wouldn't come to school because of this. In 2009 the program began with one school. With the help of the Maple Ridge Community Foundation and other supporters, it expanded to five schools in SD42. Youth Unlimited's mandate for this program is to feed hungry kids.

Maureen stated that 600 students are served meals every week.
