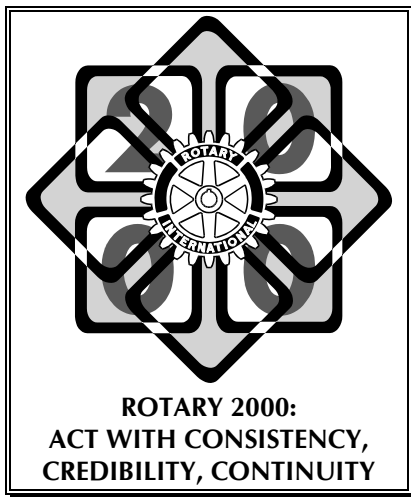
Last Weeks' Meeting
