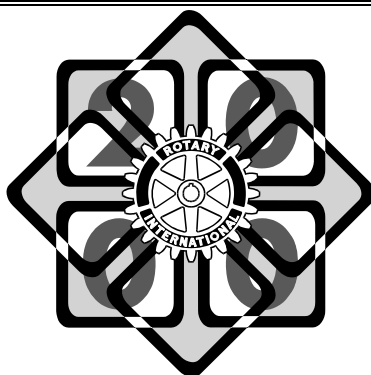

Our guest speaker was Mike Hickey the fundraiser coordinator for The King's Inn, a soup kitchen presently operating Wedn. - Monday from 22410 MacIntosh Lane M.R. (behind Jim's Pizza) Monday/Tuesday are covered by "the Salvation Army" with a very similar program. They serve approx. 20-40 people per day and are run completely by volunteers. Monthly expenses approx. \$1500.=, needed for rent,

operating and supplementary food cost. So far the Inn has been able to obtain most food by generous donations from business or service organizations. Short term goals, deep freezer, fridge, stove + approx. \$1500.= per month to be able to operate. Long term goals, to get realistic support, to be able to run an effective and un-interrupted operation. Thanks Mike, for an informative speech.
