Wild Festival for Youth, June 13th - we have been approached again to supply the lunch for this event. Brian will likely be coordinating it and will be looking for volunteers for this event.



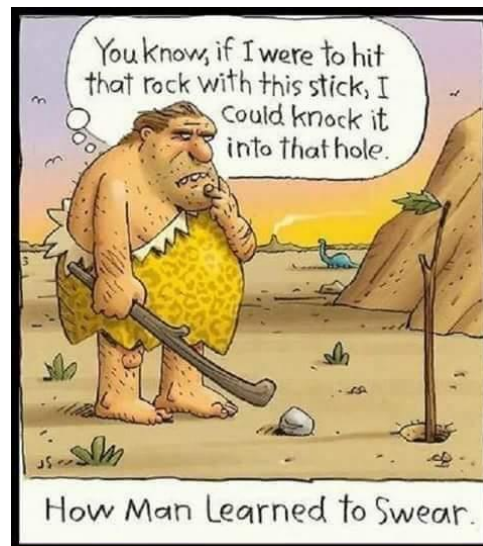

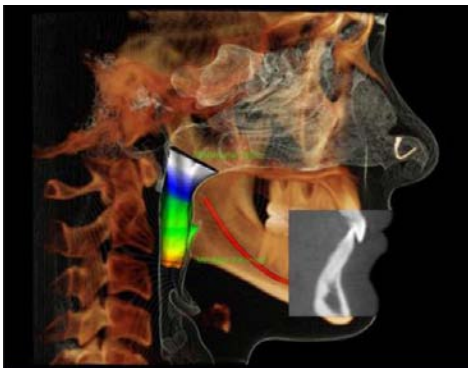


