Will you commit today to donating \$500 per year to The Rotary Foundation and start making a difference in people's lives?

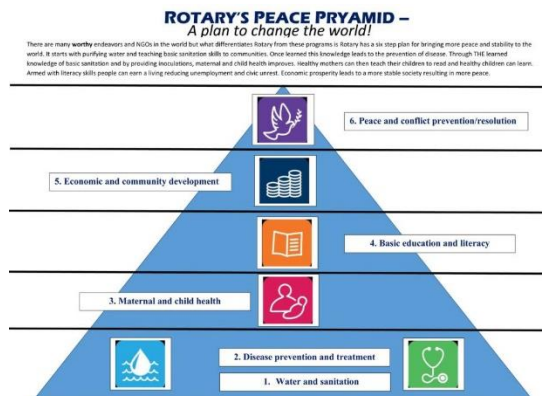


Bet you never thought that fonts could be a problem in large signs.

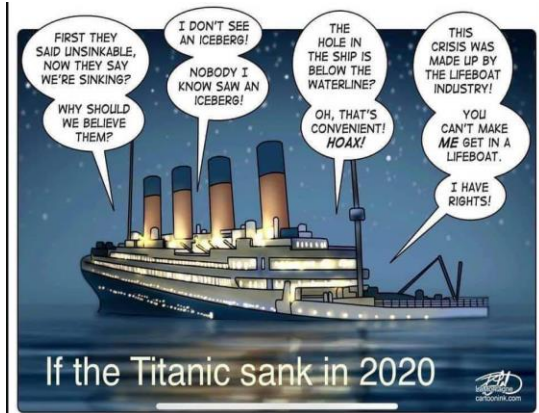

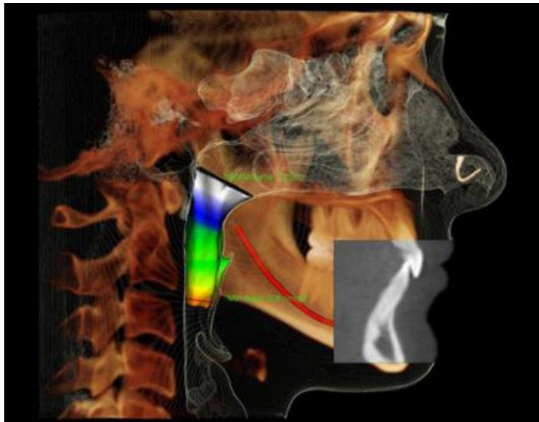
