ZOOM Meeting – April 16, 2020

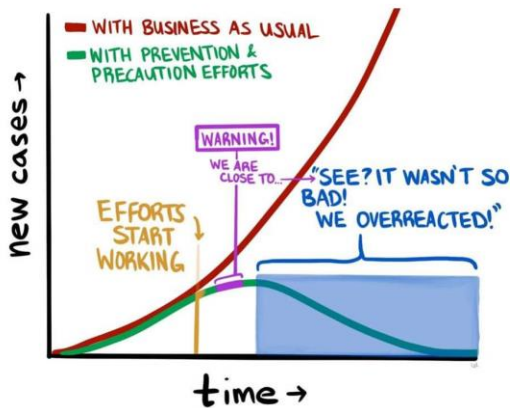
I did not attend this meeting as it was my birthday and was celebrating with my family. Many thanks to Carola for taking the notes that were used to build this newsletter.

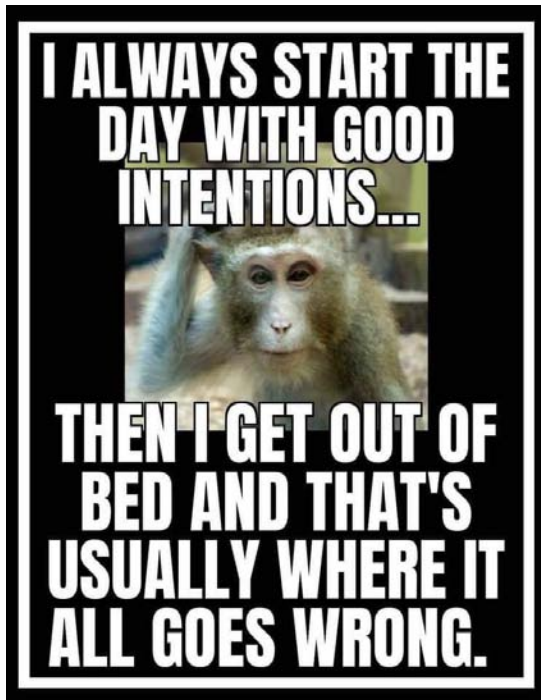

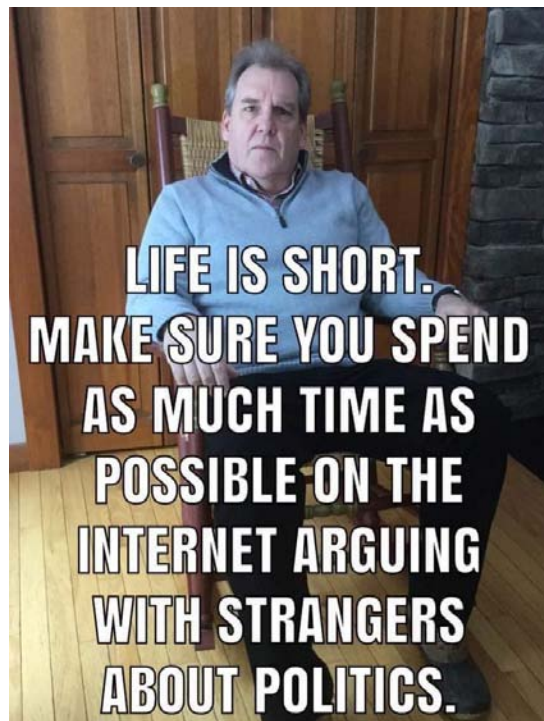

Thursday April 23, 2020 at 7 pm we will have our next Zoom Meeting.

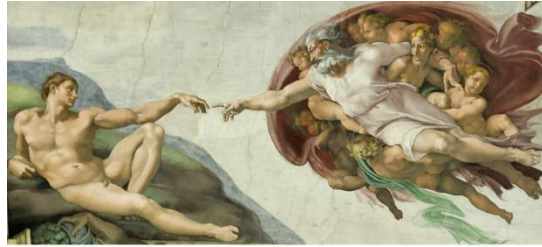

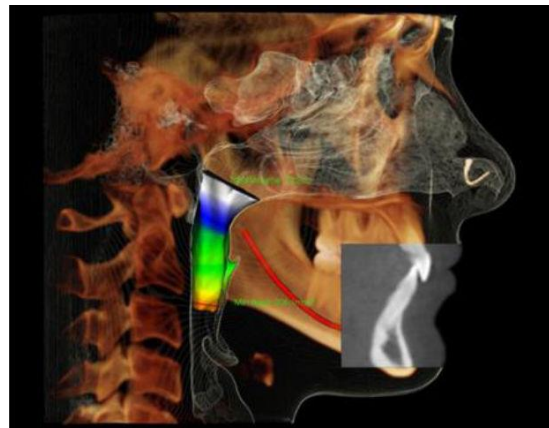


