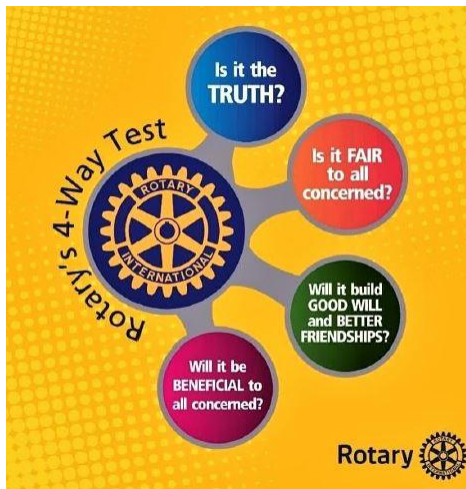

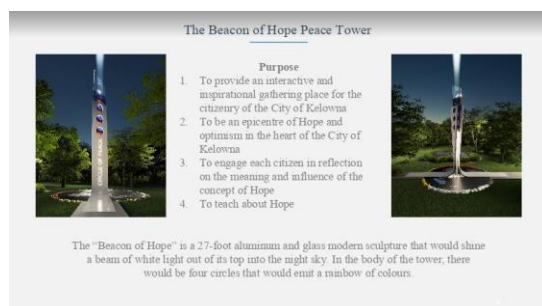
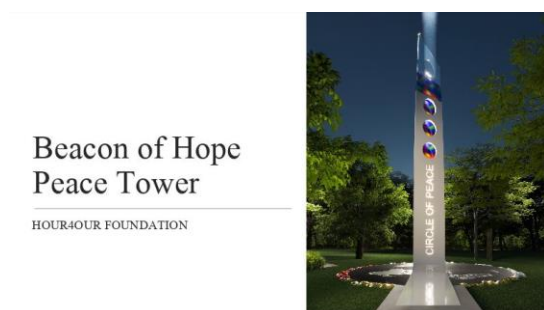
Foundation Moment –

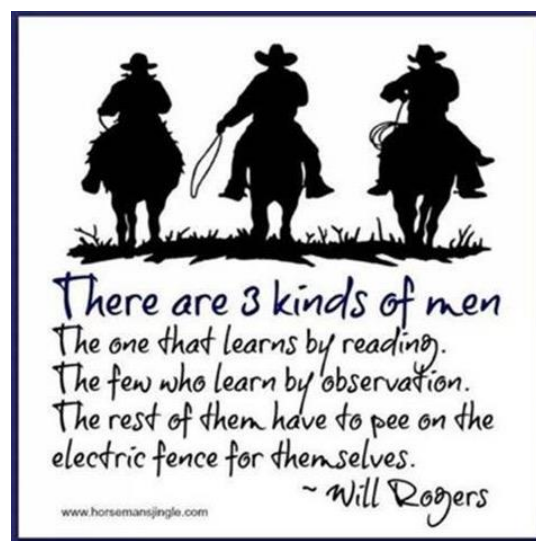

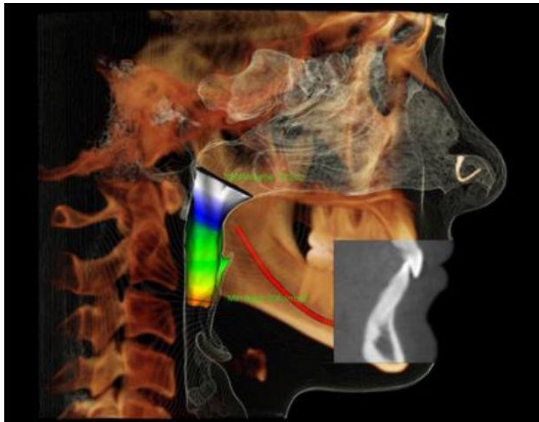
