What was the name of the pig the Douglas' neighbors, the Ziffles owned? Arnold.

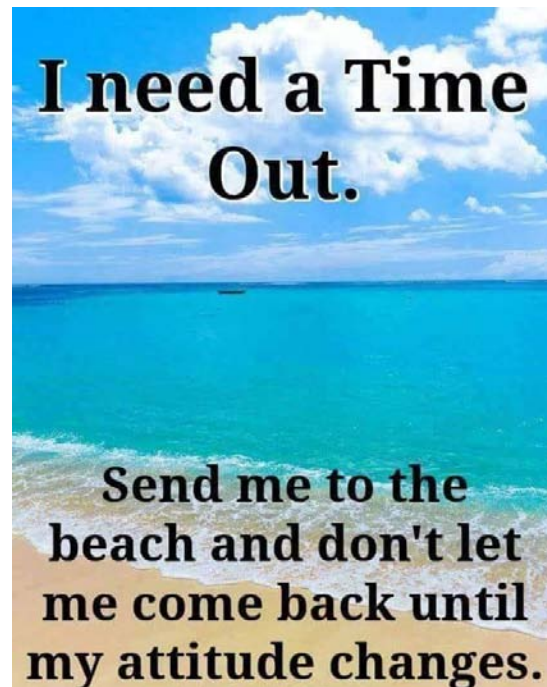

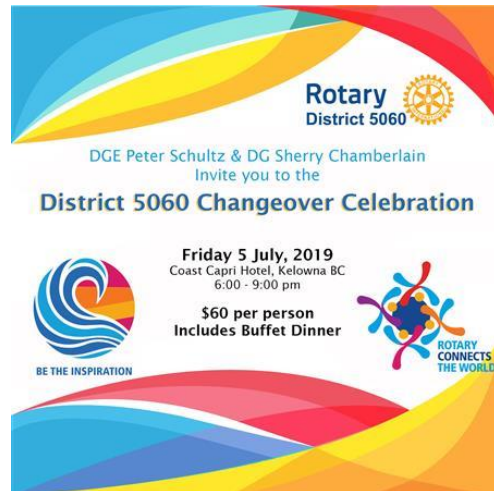


