


Friends of Rotary 'Christmas in a Bottle' Fundraiser -

The guest speaker tonight was David Crawford COSAR Search Manager accompanied by Karen Gretzinger and Samantha Sheppard.

The Central Okanagan Search & Rescue Society (formerly Kelowna SAR) is BC's oldest SAR group, and has provided search and rescue services to the Central Okanagan since 1954. The skill set of COSAR's volunteers is exceptionally broad, consisting of Rope and Swift Water Rescue Technicians, Trackers, GSAR's (Ground Search and Rescue), and Emergency Medical Responders to name only a few. COSAR responds year-round with a fleet of equipment including quads, snowmobiles, response trucks, and boats. It is difficult to attach a price tag to the selfless services provided by the volunteers at Central Okanagan Search & Rescue.






