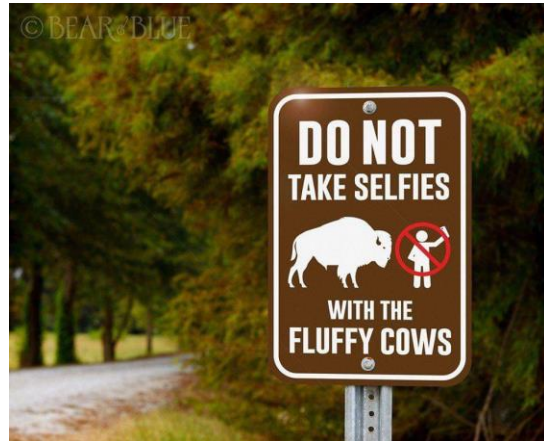
On a roll, he shifted to Greenland.



*“A wildfire has been burning in western Greenland for more than a month, illustrating the unusually dry and warm conditions there.”*

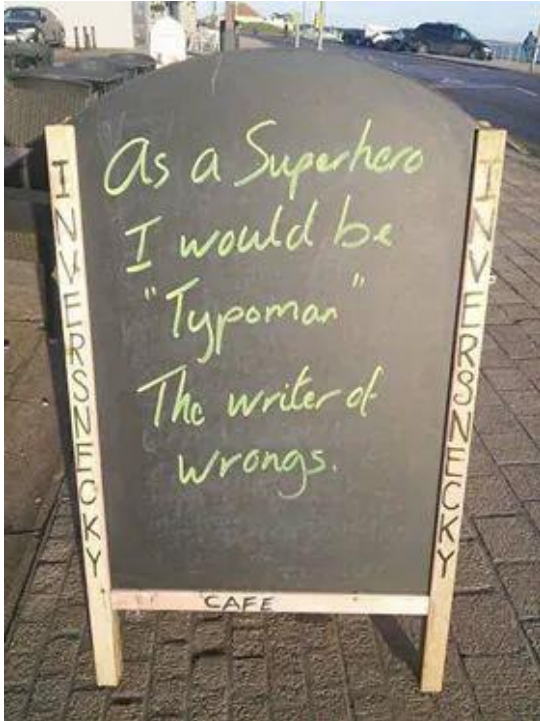
None of this can be directly linked to global warming but it can be linked to an unusual year and the possibility of more events.

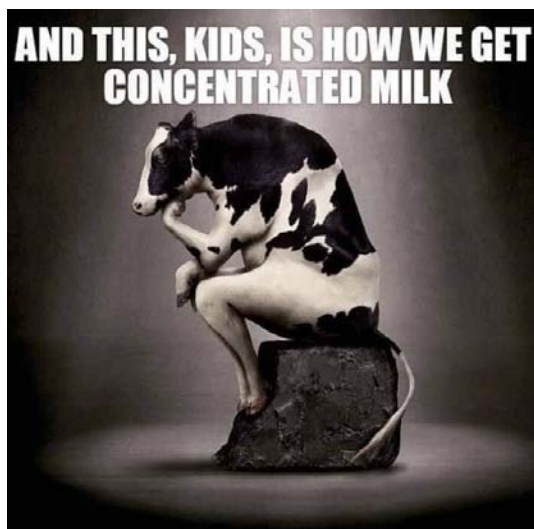

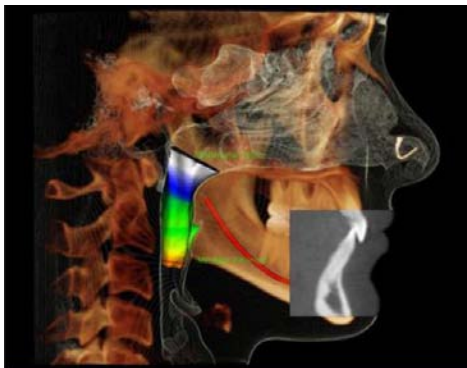


