"A wildfire has been burning in western Greenland for more than a month, illustrating the unusually dry and warm conditions there."


None of this can be directly linked to global warming but it can be linked to an unusual year and the possibility of more events.




Bocce Evening – our club's evening of Bocce Bowling and feasting will occur in September and will be held at Art and Glenna's place. I don't have the date as yet.




