He also found a message for those who drive the country roads too slow.

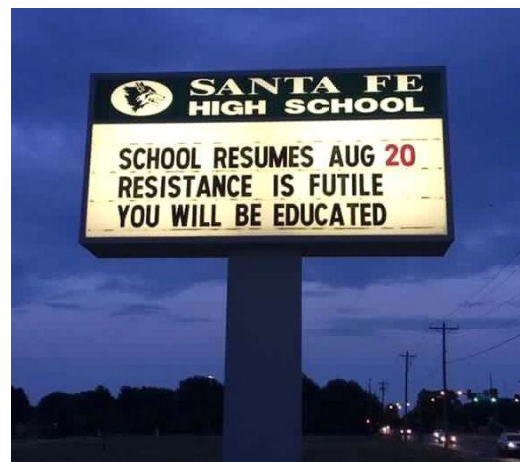


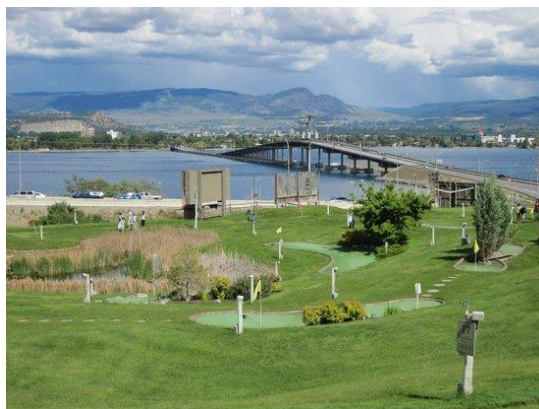
MEETING OF AUGUST 17, 2018

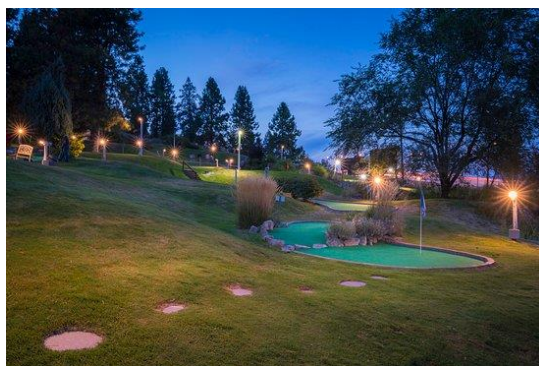

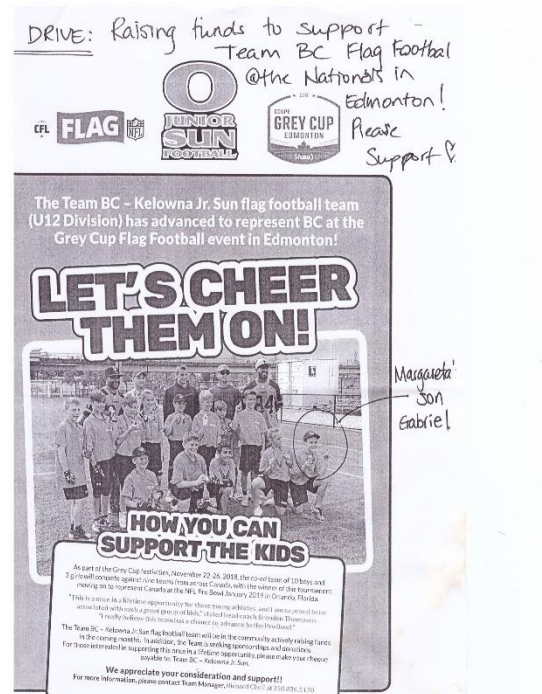

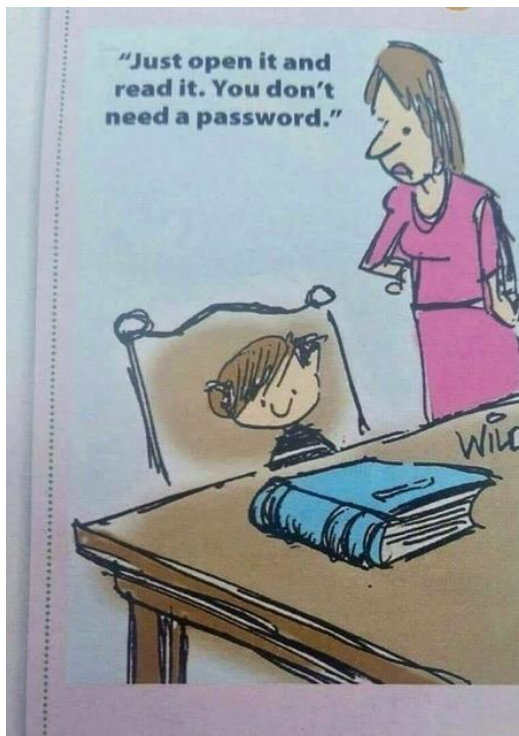
Another Good Deed – Carola has donated the empties from our bocce night and some more empties donated by Barb to a fundraiser.
