#### **GUEST SPEAKER**



The Assistant District Governor presented a video on Mary Hughes's speech at the PETS Conference in Portland.

Nancy Hughes had joined the Portland Rotary Club following her husband's death and described herself as 'the reluctant Rotarian'. When she discovered that some three billion people in the world use fire to cook on and that the smoke from them kills about five million people a year, mostly children under 5 years of age. mostly children. Obtaining the support of her Rotary Club and through a series of trials they developed the Ecocina stove that was not only safer to use but also reduced tree consumption by being more efficient.

With the continuing support of her Rotary Club and addition Rotary Clubs they moved on to supporting local entrepreneurs to set up factories to build and sell these stoves. Fire Team International, a non-profit organization now has factories in Guatemala, El Salvador, Honduras and Nicarauga. Rotary Clubs in the U.S., Mexico, and Nicaragua are planning new factories.




