Which BC city is considered Canada's smallest? (*Greenwood*)

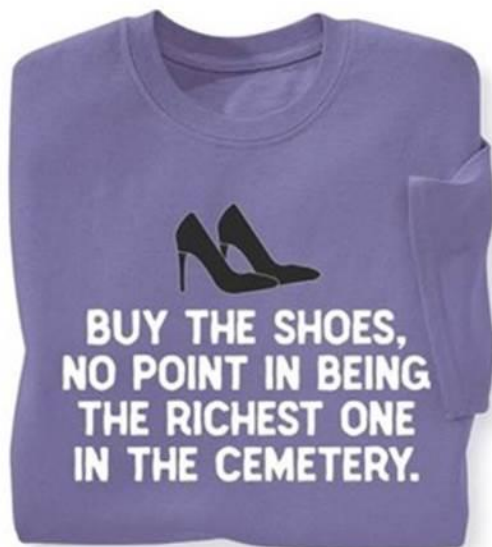
Where is Likely, BC near? (*Williams Lake*)

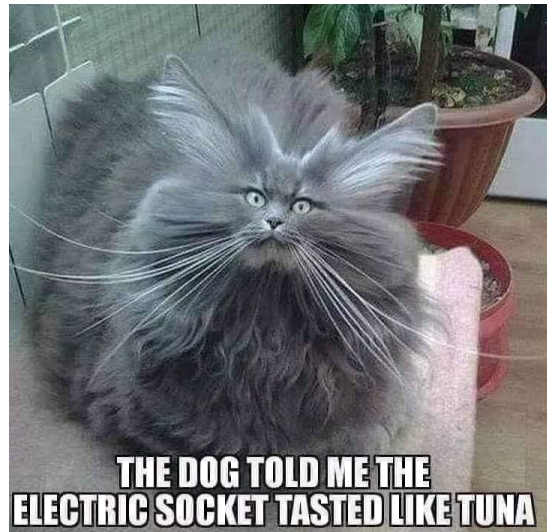

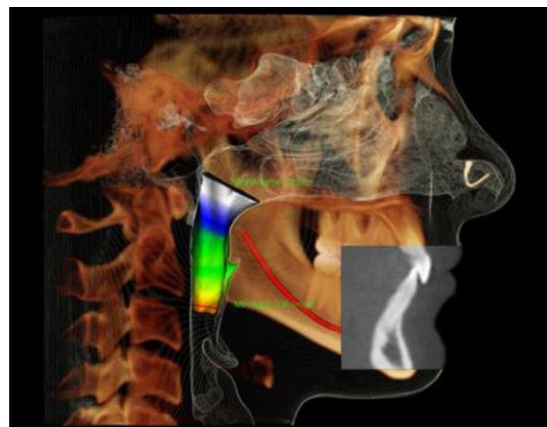


