ZOOM MEETING


We were once have gathered on ZOOM. Our guest speaker was Angela Stadnyk from the Salvation Army. Unfortunately, I failed to capture a group shot.





"During my time as a Rotary scholar, I learned to look at development differently. The anthropology of development aims to analyze global aid in another way. We pay particular attention to how initiatives play out on the ground to determine just what local communities' needs are and how those needs might be met sustainably and, eventually, autonomously...Rotarians understand that to have the most impact, we need to learn from other cultures. Feb 14-21, 2021 come enjoy the great outdoors for a good cause!


For just \$10 you can ski and snowshoe on over 130 km of beautiful groomed trails at your own pace in a socially distanced and safe environment.


