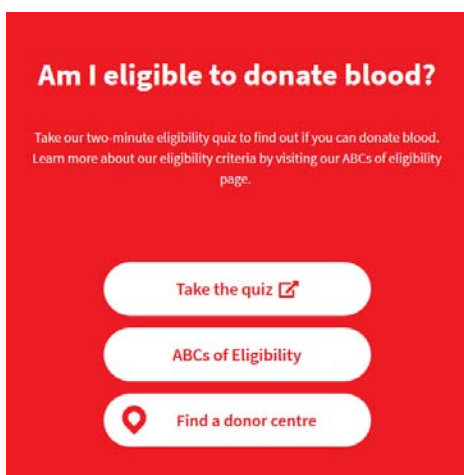


Blood Services Event, March 21st –
