

#### Meteorological Trivia





**Wingtip vortices** are circular patterns of rotating air left behind a wing as it generates lift. Note that the vortices are counter rotating



Von Karman Vortex Street Downwind from an island. Cause is a cloud layer is present at the altitude where the vortices are created, the streets become visible.



Ship tracks in fog over ocean. Cause is likely moisture addition from engines being stirred by ship motion. Particles of sulphur dioxide in the smoke plumes produced by cargo ships have been found to have a cooling effect.


