I passed around my autographed picture that my Mom ordered for me when I was 4 or 5. Apparently, I was a big Bonanza fan.



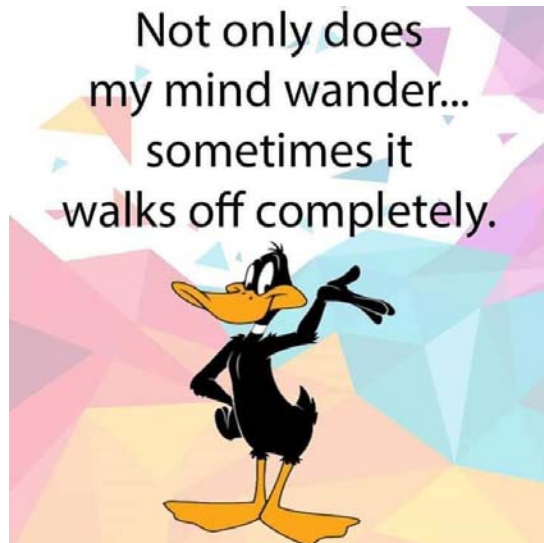
