Trail App – work continues by the executive to understand our obligations and costs with the ale trail.


Foundation – Lockie has requested that any final donations to the Foundation be given ti him at the next meeting (June 14th)


The next sale of bottles will occur at KGH on June 14th from 10 am to 2 pm.

to accompany her.


