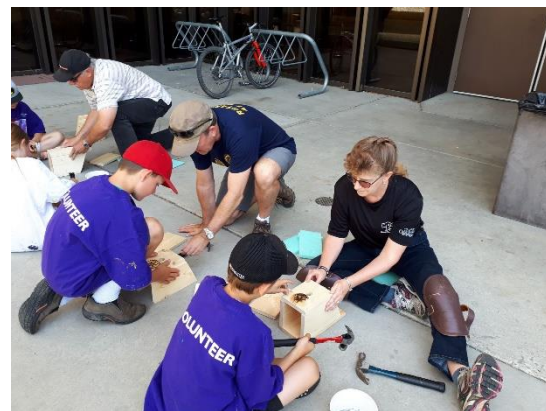
I hope there were not many leftovers and that we counted well (?) Of course we realize there are always no shows - students that just can't make it for whatever reason.
