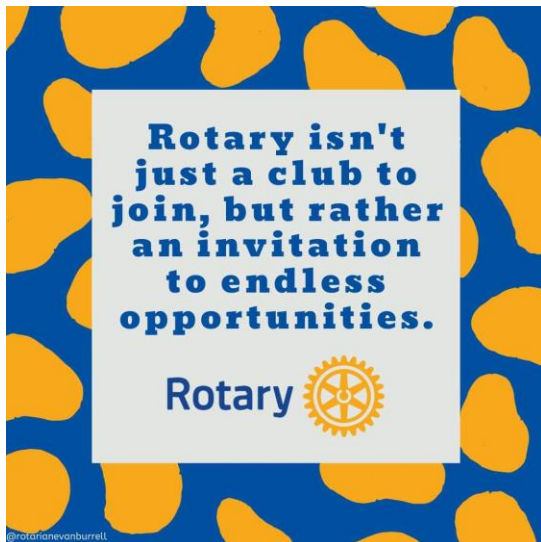
We also had a guest visitor, Jose Hernandez who is a local artist in Kelowna.
