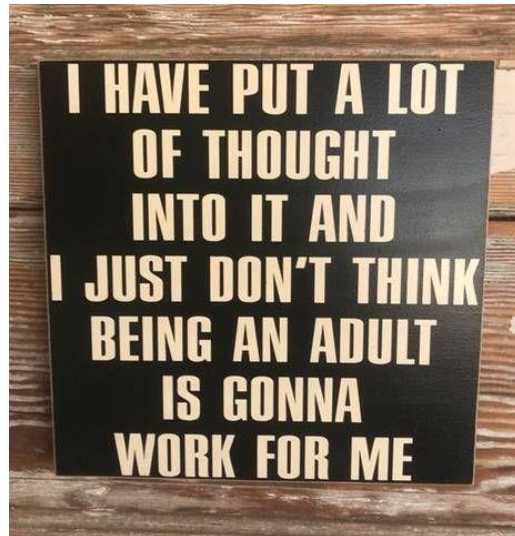
**ATTENDANCE** – 65%

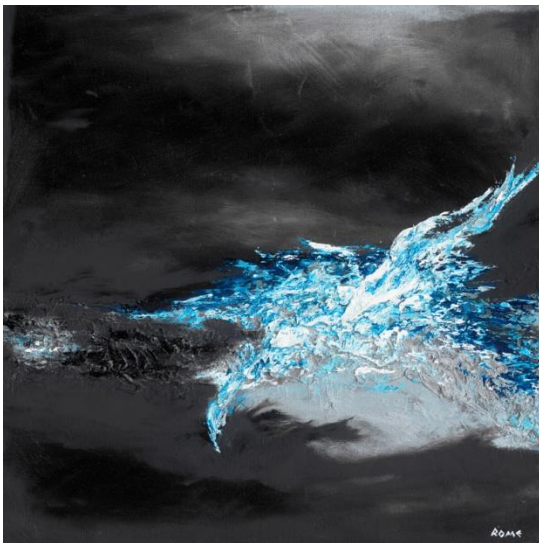
