Kelowna Women's Shelter – Allison McLaughlan, the Executive Director of the Kelowna Women's Shelter joined us briefly to to thank us for our donation and to give us a rundown on their capacity, needs and future plans of the organization. She then answered questions from the group before leaving.

East Kelowna Hall Project– Bob Lemon reported that he didn't exactly know what was going on with the hall (his contact has been hard to get hold of) but it was moving forward.

Peace Park – President Jack has been speaking with city hall about building a Peace Park within Kelowna. While the talks are in the early stage about where and how we could provide volunteer time, he has found some interest and also learned that a tenthousand-dollar grant can be applied for.

Just out of curiosity I looked up what a Peace Park was. According to Monsieur Google a "*Park* for *Peace*" is a special designation that may be applied to conservation areas dedicated to the promotion, celebration and/or commemoration of *peace* and cooperation. This designation is defined by the International Union for Conservation of Nature and there are currently 147 such parks in the world.

Rotary Action Group for Peace – a motion was put forward at the last meeting about RC Kelowna Capri becoming a Peace Builder Club. Since then we have learned that there are no direct costs to a club, that training programs are available at the Rotary Peace Academy and that we must carry out one peace project per year. After some discussion the motion was passed by the members. Lockie Bracken as the champion of the concept will now lead us in this new direction.
