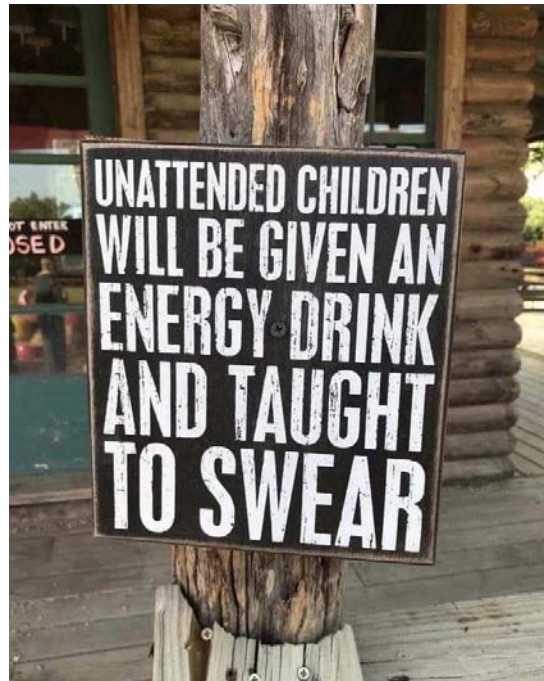

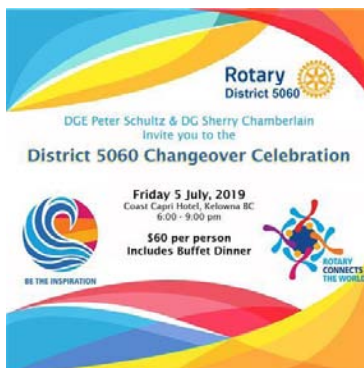
Membership – Mike has secured a spot for our club at the Downtown Event on July 13th.

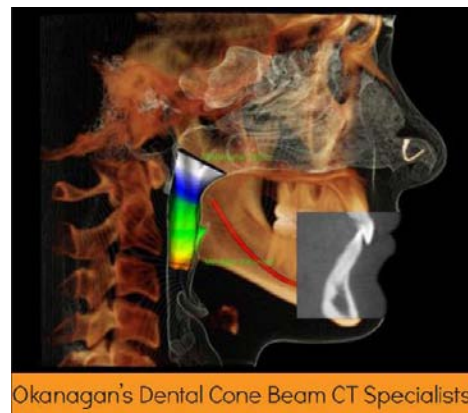

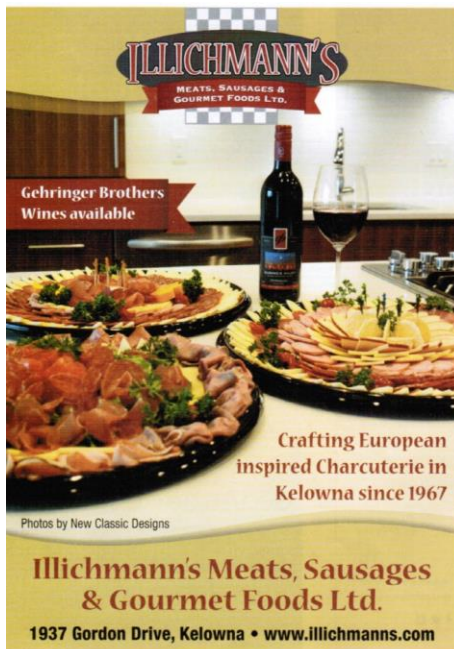
