Wild Festival for Youth, June 13th - we have been approached again to supply the lunch for this event. Brian is coordinating our contribution and will be looking for volunteers for this event.

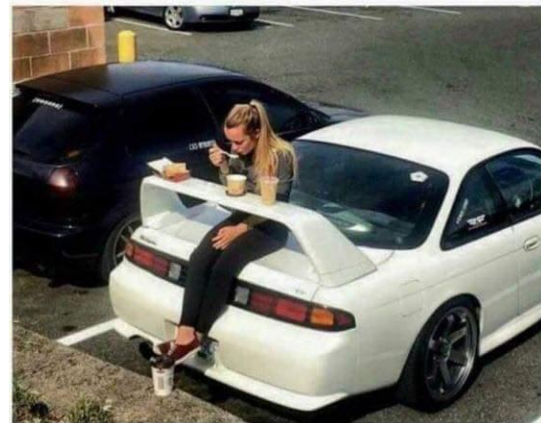

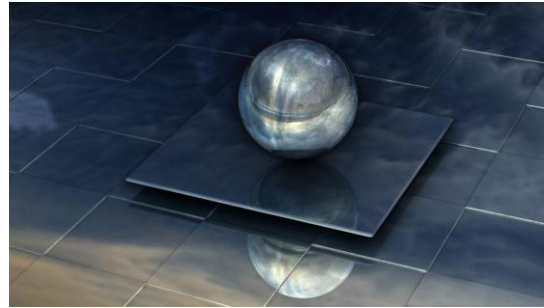

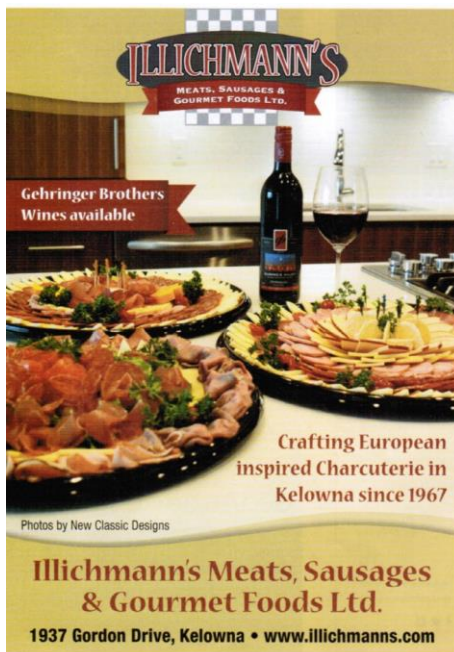
