Sheriff Lockie was thinking of landfills this week and so chose some questions on this topic to challenge us. Questions such as "What percentage of BC residents oppose single-use plastic bags? (81%); how much material goes into landfills in Canada each year? (near 31 million metric tonnes); how many landfills are there in Canada? (10,000); what percentage of the waste is recycled in Canada? (30%) and what country has the highest recycling rate? (Sweden - Of the household waste produced in Sweden in 2017, around 15.5 percent was used for biological recycling, 33.8 percent for material recycling and 50.2 percent went to energy recovery). Lockie did Sweden one better, he recycled 100% of our fines into club revenue.


