Cottonwoods Christmas Party – everything is on track. Biggest change will be that guests will be assigned to hosts at the door.



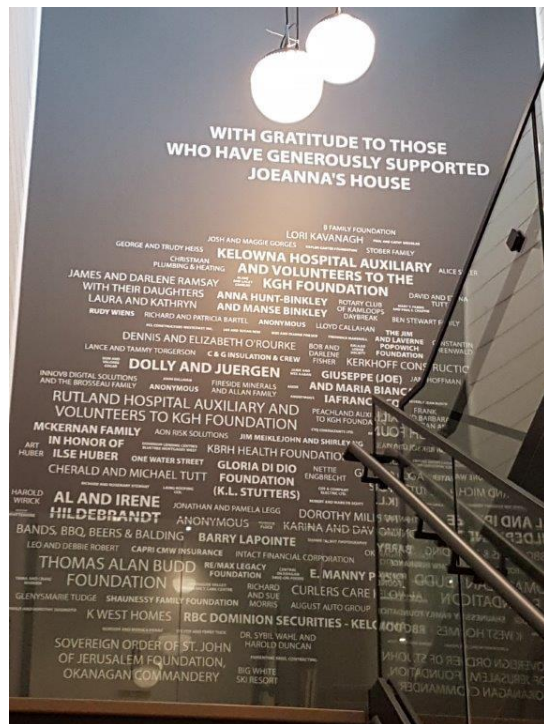
JoAnna's House – Members of the club visited Joanna's House on Nov. 5th. It is still be outfitted for the Nov. 21st opening but impressive to see.



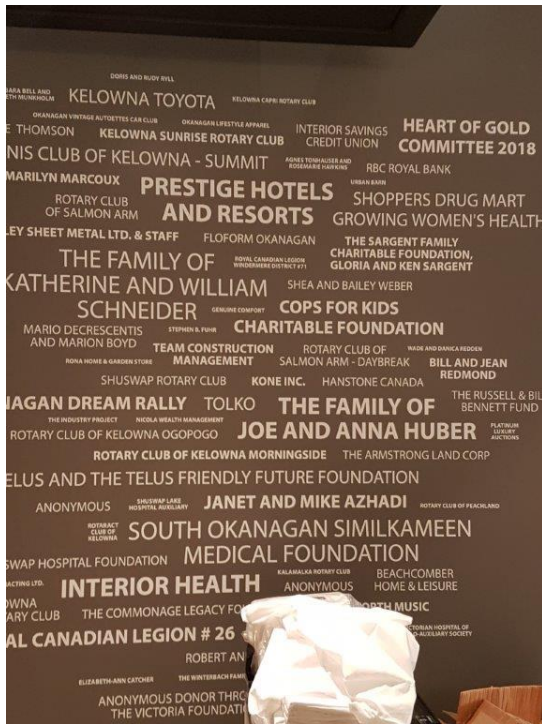

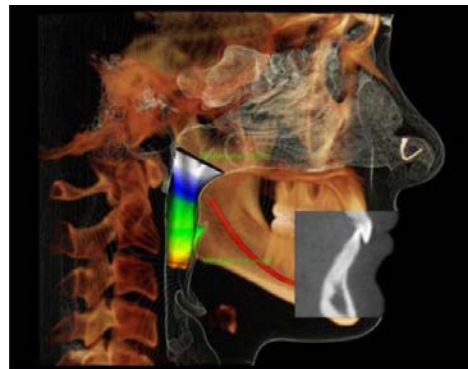
