The black and yellow colours shown in the picture represent the city of Munich that was founded in 1158 AD. The black represents the original founding monks and the yellow is the colour of the city official's sashes. On the banner it says Munchen Mitte which today means Munich Centre but it should be noted that the word München ('home of the monks') stems from an early monastery founded in the 8th century. The back side of the banner is blue and white which are the colours of the Bavarian flag.

Thank you, Johann and the RC Munich Centre, for this banner with so much history reflected in it.
