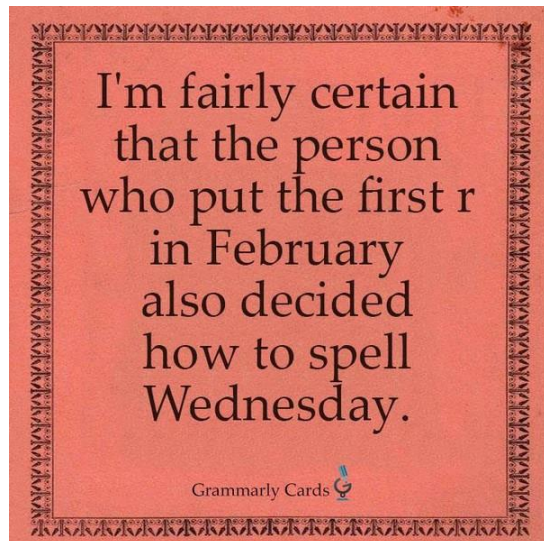
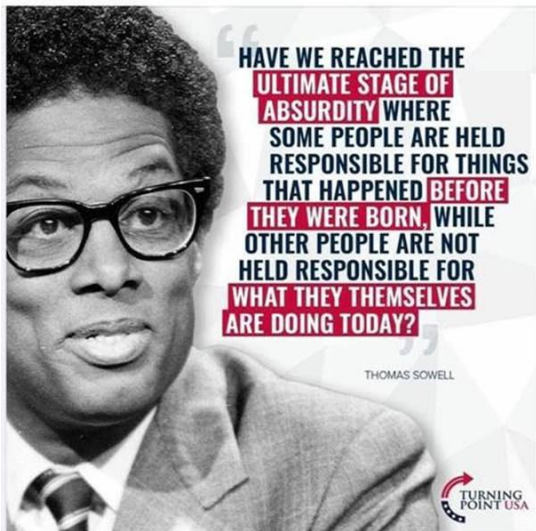

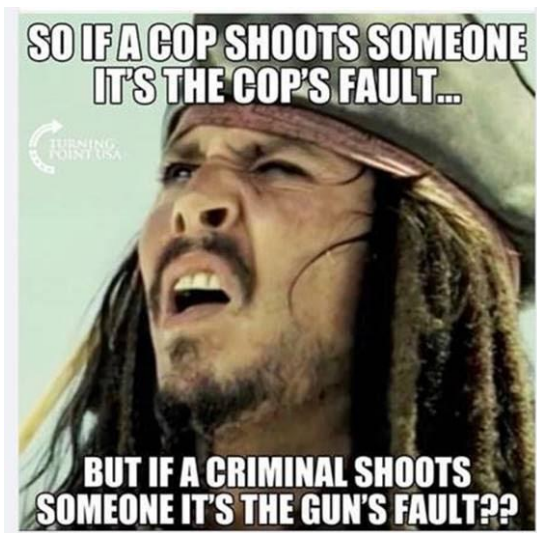




GUEST SPEAKER

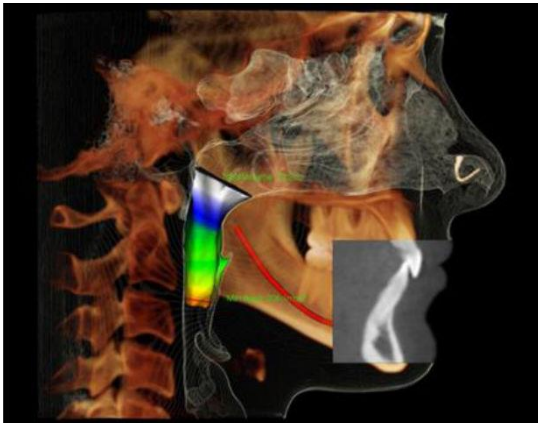
