

This evening's speaker was Bob Lemon who spoke on the history of St. Michael and All Angels Cathedral in Kelowna. In particular he described the reasons why the cathedral, originally built in 1913 had to be totally dismantled and then rebuilt. It was a very interesting presentation, and that the entire cost of \$1.7 million dollars came from the congregation except for \$3,163 which came from the City of Kelowna because it was a historical building.
