

Update on Glen - Ed talked to Glen's former partner who had been talking to Glen's son. He advised that there will not be any service for Glen until maybe October.




The new Child Advocacy Centre in Kelowna will be a child friendly facility dedicated to providing all of the necessary resources and support for children and their families impacted by abuse






