Club Raffle Provides Increased Revenue for Community Service

For the fourth year in a row, the Rotary Club of Kelowna Sunrise Raffle has increased its revenue due to increased sale of raffle tickets. This means that there are even more funds available to support humanitarian and other needs within the community.

At the regular meeting of the club on August 30th, Bob Fortier, the on-going chair of the Raffle program committee shared that the club had gross sales of \$32,030 with an net profit of \$30,500. This included the sale blitz during the August 23-25 Interior Savings Sunrise Rotary RibFest which resulted in sales amounting to \$11,745.
