Rotary Club Donates Record Amount of Funding to Local Organizations

During the Rotary year 2022/23, the Rotary Club of Kelowna Sunrise donated \$234,517 to Kelowna and Central Okanagan not-for-profit organizations, providing a record amount of funding for a Rotary year for humanitarian service. In the previous Rotary year, the club had donated \$149,015.

The windfall of funding during the past two Rotary years has come about through the "Season of Giving" Calendar fundraising campaigns that first started in the fall of 2021.

The major recipients of the funding since 2021 have been the Kelowna General Hospital Foundation and the Child Advocacy Centre which have each received \$128,500.

Over the past ten years, 2013/14 to and including 2022/23, the Rotary Club of Kelowna Sunrise with the support of the community and its Rotary members, have contributed \$841,854 to respond to community humanitarian needs.
