

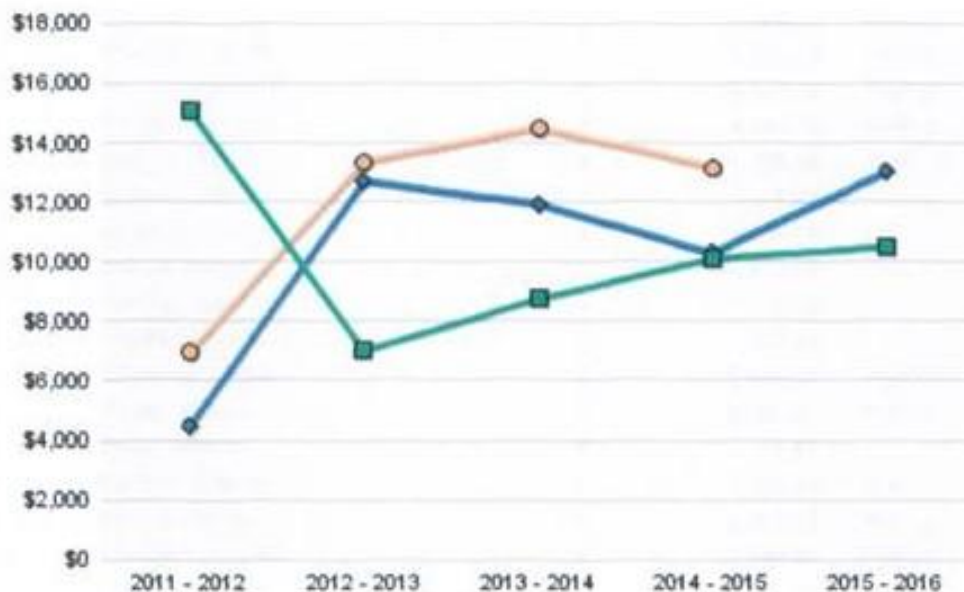
Club Members Value the Work of The Rotary Foundation

Without a doubt, the members of the Rotary Club of Kelowna Sunrise continue to recognize the need to support those in need around the world through the Rotary Foundation Annual Fund. With two and one half months still to go in the current Rotary year, the members of the club have already surpassed their Annual Fund Goal for 2015-16. As of April 10, 2015, the club members had donated \$US12,985 to the Annual Fund and in doing so had donated \$US2485 more than the set goal.

Even with the poor value of the Canadian dollar against the American green back, members of the club have clearly demonstrated commitment in helping those less fortunate by digging deeper into their pockets to make up the shortfall. Well done club members!

At the current time in the Rotary year, members have donated \$US188 per capita, well above the district per capita giving of \$US108.

All members of the club have contributed during the Rotary year, as they have over the past three years, to enable the club to be an "Every Rotarian Every Year" (EREY) for the fourth consecutive year. Twenty-eight of these members are Sustaining Members in that they have already contributed over \$US100 this year.
