## Progress with the Uganda Mityana Farm Project

purchased. As well, the stand for the water tank had been constructed and was now ready to be erected with the water tank placed on top.





The report was prepared by Echel Andrew, the ISEE Project Coordinator for Uganda following a visit to the Farm and Orphanage where he observed the progress and met with Reverend Allan Boaris, the new mission supervisor with the Missionary of the Poor organization in Kampala, Uganda.

The Mityana Farm Project was approved at the beginning of the 2014-15 Rotary Year and is a joint project of the Rotary Club of Kelowna Sunrise and the Rotary Club of Kampala Sunrise (Uganda) in partnership with the Missionary of the Poor in Kampala, Uganda. The Rotary Club of Kelowna Sunrise has contributed US\$11,062, District 5060 has matched these funds with another US\$11,062, and the Rotary Club of Kampala Sunrise has provided an additional US\$3000 to the project.
