Club Surpasses Annual Fund Donation Goal

The Rotary Club of Kelowna Sunrise, with still one-half of the 2013-14 Rotary left, has exceeded its Annual Fund goal with donations from club members reaching \$10,589, well above the goal of \$8750 established at the beginning of the Rotary year. By December 31st, those members who have contributed to the

fund have enabled the club to achieve 121 % of its goal which results in a \$162.91 per capita achievement.

With participation from members who have still not contributed to the fund, it is anticipated that the club could easily achieve 160 percent of its goal.



One of the goals that the club has not yet achieved this Rotary year is to attain a classification as an EREY (Every Rotarian Every Year). This requires that 100 percent of the club members make a donation of at least \$US10. It is important that all members of the club recognize that any donation to the Annual Fund will make a great difference in the lives of people in third world countries who are experiencing poverty, illiteracy and malnutrition.
