

Club Member Continues Financial Support for Humanitarian Service

Kelowna Sunrise member Paul Bamford was honored on January 31, 2020, for his continuing financial support of The Rotary Foundation and the humanitarian service it does worldwide. Club Foundation Chair, Leslie Munro presented Paul with another multiple Paul Harris Fellow pin, a PHF+8 pin, for his contributions of over US\$9000 to the Foundation since he became a Rotarian.



During the meeting, Leslie Munro shared that the Rotary Club of Kelowna Sunrise has 70% of its members as sustaining members and 50% of its members as Paul Harris Fellows. Forty-eight of these members are still actively supporting the Foundation with financial donations. Additionally, Munro stated that 19 members are benefactors, while nine members are Major Donors. To date, the club members have supported with financial contributions of US\$346,566.

Sustaining members are those Rotarians who give US\$100 and over per year to the Foundation; Paul Harris Fellows are members who have donated over US\$1000 in total to the Foundation; Benefactors are members who have made provisions in their estate plan for the Foundation, or who have made an outright gift of US\$1,000 or more to the Endowment Fund; and Major Donors are those who have achieved a cumulative level of donations of at least US\$10,000 to the Foundation.
