

Club Surpasses Goals for Funding for the Rotary Foundation

Each year, including the current Rotary Year of 2016-17, the club increases its goal to raise funds for the Annual Fund of the Rotary Foundation. Each year, the club members step up and achieve and surpass this goal. This speaks highly of the generosity of the club's members and their continuing commitment to assist those in need around the world through the work of the Foundation. It also clearly points out that the members of the club recognize that the Rotary Foundation's fiscal management and the achievements it attains are the reasons why the Rotary Foundation is by far the most respected Foundation in the world.



With three and one-half months still to go within the 2016-17 Rotary Year, club members have surpassed the Annual Fund goal of US\$14,000 by donating US\$18,911, a per capita donation of US\$282.25, shattering its previous record per capita high of US\$223. Members have also donated an additional US\$1494 to the Polio Fund, just shy of the goal of US\$1500. With donations to the endowment fund of US\$1746 the club members have already contributed a total of US\$22,151 to the Rotary Foundation.

Since its charter as a club within Rotary International, the Rotary Club of Rotary Sunrise has donated US\$308,339 to the various programs of the Foundation.
