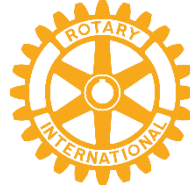

FUNDING APPLICATION CRITERIA

The Rotary Club of Salmon Arm welcomes the opportunity to consider requests for financial support for local projects that address one or more of the Rotary Areas of Focus:

- Disease prevention
- Providing clean water, sanitation, and hygiene
- Peace and conflict prevention/resolution
- Education
- Literacy
- Maternal and child health
- Growing local economies
- Supporting the environment

Grants are only awarded for projects. All projects must have well-defined objectives, start and completion dates, areas of responsibility assigned to individuals, contact information, an obligation to report the status and outcome of the project upon request, and a commitment to provide due recognition to the Rotary Club of Salmon Arm.

The project may include the purchase of capital assets, which typically are equipment or tools that may be used indefinitely, that is, beyond the completion of the project. Salaries or other forms of labour compensation are not typically supported as “sweat equity” or volunteerism is expected. However, fees for expertise such as guest speakers, educators or consultants might be considered on an exceptional basis.

Requests for financial support to meet ongoing operating costs, such as rent, utilities, interest and supplies will not be considered as these items are not projects as defined above.

In order for an application to be considered, ALL information requested in the application form must be provided.

Applications are welcome from individuals and non-profit organizations. Individuals must provide a brief biography or resume that demonstrates their ability to successfully complete the proposed project. Non-profit organizations must provide documents that describe the mission, vision or other value statements that relate to their commitment and ability to successfully complete the proposed project.

The mission of Rotary is to provide service to others, promote integrity, and advance world understanding, goodwill, and peace through the fellowship of business, professional, and community leaders. Rotary is a non-political, non-religious organization. Membership in Rotary is an opportunity to become a leader or enhance leadership skills and abilities.

The Rotary Club of Salmon Arm looks forward to considering projects that advance our mission. New members are always welcome.
