



Juneau Glacier Valley Rotary 2009-2010 Foundation “Matching Program”



The club will match dollar for dollar every contribution you make to The Rotary Foundation (TRF) from December 1, 2009 through January 31, 2010 based on the guidelines below:

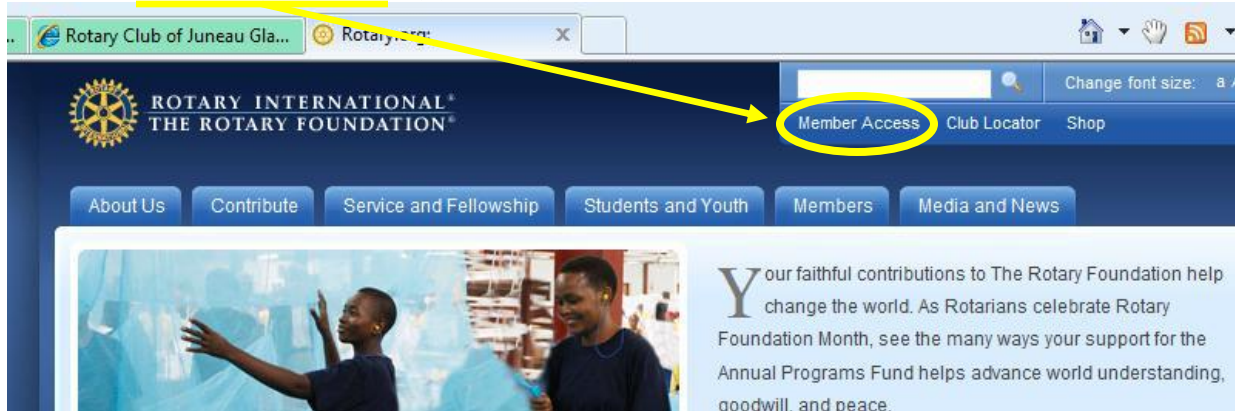
- The limit in matching funds available to any one Rotarian in this year will be \$250
- Matching is offered on amounts ABOVE your \$100 sustaining contribution for the year
- For those on automatic quarterly payments to TRF that add up to \$100 or more within the Rotary year, you will be considered to have “met” your sustaining contribution requirement, and can apply for the matching program to match up to \$250 of your additional contribution to TRF
- If you would like to find out where you are at with your TRF contributions, you can go online (see instructions included) or contact [Chris Letterman](mailto:Chris.Letterman@gmail.com) (*Chris.Letterman@gmail.com*). He can especially assist you in determining this amount if you are on a quarterly payment system or have a payment “pending” that isn’t showing up in your account yet. (For instance, if you are trying to determine how close you are to your next “Paul Harris Fellow” (PHF) Chris can project how much you need in addition to any quarterly contributions for the year and amounts pending)

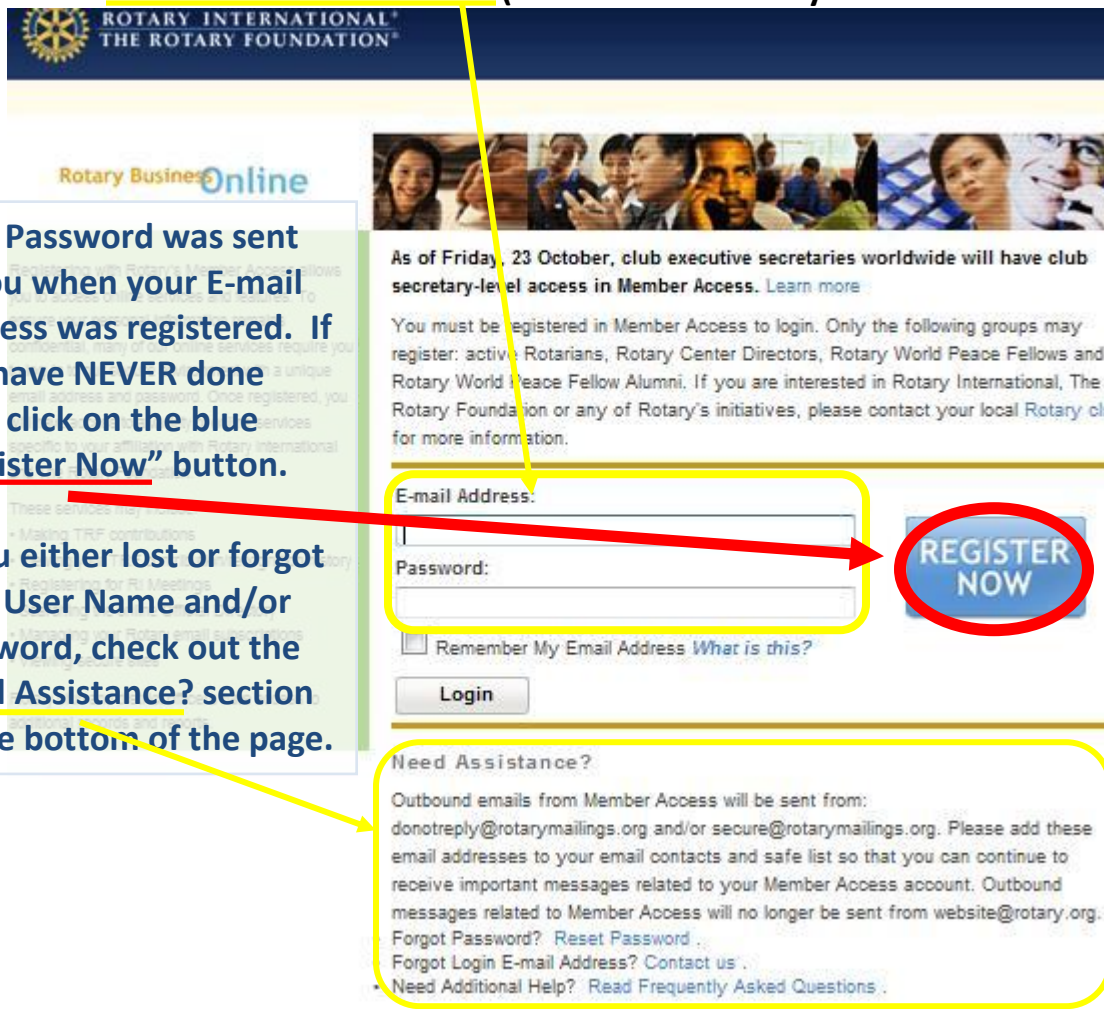
TO FIND YOUR FOUNDATION CONTRIBUTION HISTORY AND CURRENT BALANCE ONLINE:

Enter **User Name** and **Password** (Your User Name is your E-mail Address)
