We are pleased to have you as a new member of the Juneau Glacier Valley Rotary Club. Your induction to the club is just the first step of a very important orientation process designed to quickly acquaint you with other members, as well as the operations of the club and Rotary in general. The sooner you are fully engaged as a member, the sooner your commitment to the ideal of “Service Above Self” can be employed.

With that goal in mind, we have devised what we call the “Badge Pass Process.”

Red Badge: As a new member, you have been issued a Red Badge as part of your induction to the club, which identifies you as a new member and encourages current members to assist you with your orientation to Rotary. You will use this Red Badge until you have completed the Badge Pass Task List on this form.

Blue Badge: Once you have completed the Badge Pass Task List, your Red Badge will be exchanged for your permanent Blue Badge. While schedules will influence the time frame for completion, your goal should be to complete the Badge Pass Task List within 30 days.

You are not alone in this mission! Your sponsor, club officers and Badge Pass Chair will assist with scheduling the various tasks. As they are completed, mark the completion date on the Badge Pass Task List next to the item you have accomplished. When finished, both you and your sponsor will sign the form and return it to the Badge Pass Chair. At the next scheduled meeting, you will receive your permanent Blue Badge and Rotary vest, and take your place within the membership, read to welcome other new members to the Juneau Glacier Valley Rotary Club.

1 Familiarize yourself with Rotary International and our club's websites		
	Go to www.rotary.org , select 'member access' from the upper right hand side of the page and register at the prompt. Print your confirmation page and return with this form.	
	Access the Juneau Glacier Valley Rotary club website at www.glaciervalleyrotary.org and add your personal information and photo on the membership page. The club secretary will provide you your username and password for initially logging on and can help you with how to do this.	
2 Select a committee (or committees)		
	Visit the Club Committee page (link on the upper left corner of the GVR Home Page) and locate the name of a Committee Chairman for a committee you are interested in serving on. Email the Committee Chairman and ask to be assigned to their committee. Do this by sending an email from the club's website (use the "email message center" in the communication module (must log in first))	
3 Get to know the club members and board		
	Volunteer to serve as 'greeter' to welcome Rotarians to a weekly meeting.	
	Give your classification talk (see 'classification talk' guidelines in orientation folder).	
	Share a 'happy buck' at a meeting	
4 Optional - Suggested additional ways to learn about Rotary		
	Ask your sponsor or a GVR member to attend a meeting with you at the Juneau Rotary club ("Downtown Club"); meets Tuesdays at noon at the Baranof Hotel.	
	Ask your sponsor or a GVR member to attend a meeting with you at the Gastineau Rotary club ("Breakfast Club"); meets Thursday mornings at 7:00am at T.K. McGuires.	
	Attend a regularly scheduled GVR board meeting (held monthly).	
	Read the "ABC's of Rotary" booklet and review the "Club Committee" manual on our website.	
	Sit at a different table every week.	
	Attend a Fireside - this provides an opportunity to visit with Rotarians in a casual setting outside a lunch meeting.	
	Attend a committee meeting; even if you aren't on the committee.
