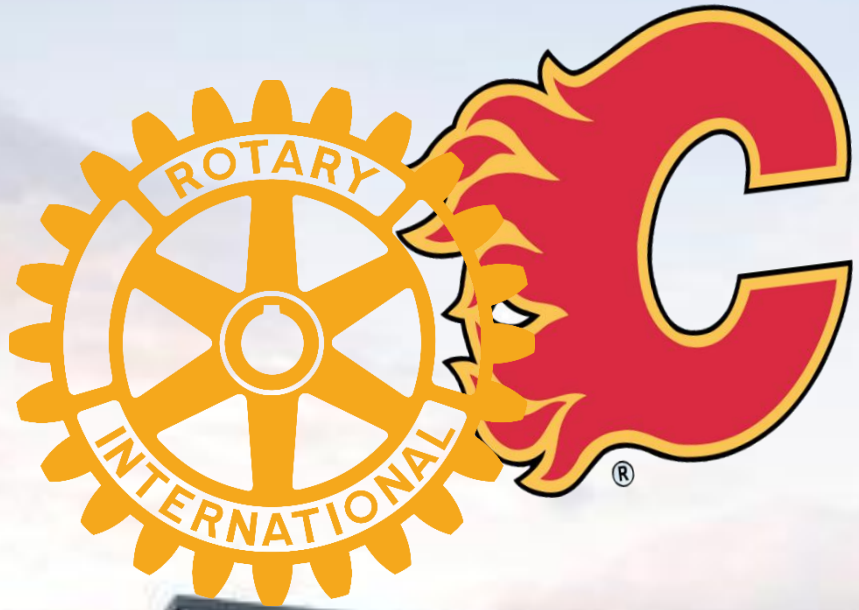


# COMMUNITY SERVICE FUNDS 2012 & 2013



**TOTAL OVER \$1,200,000 IN 2013**





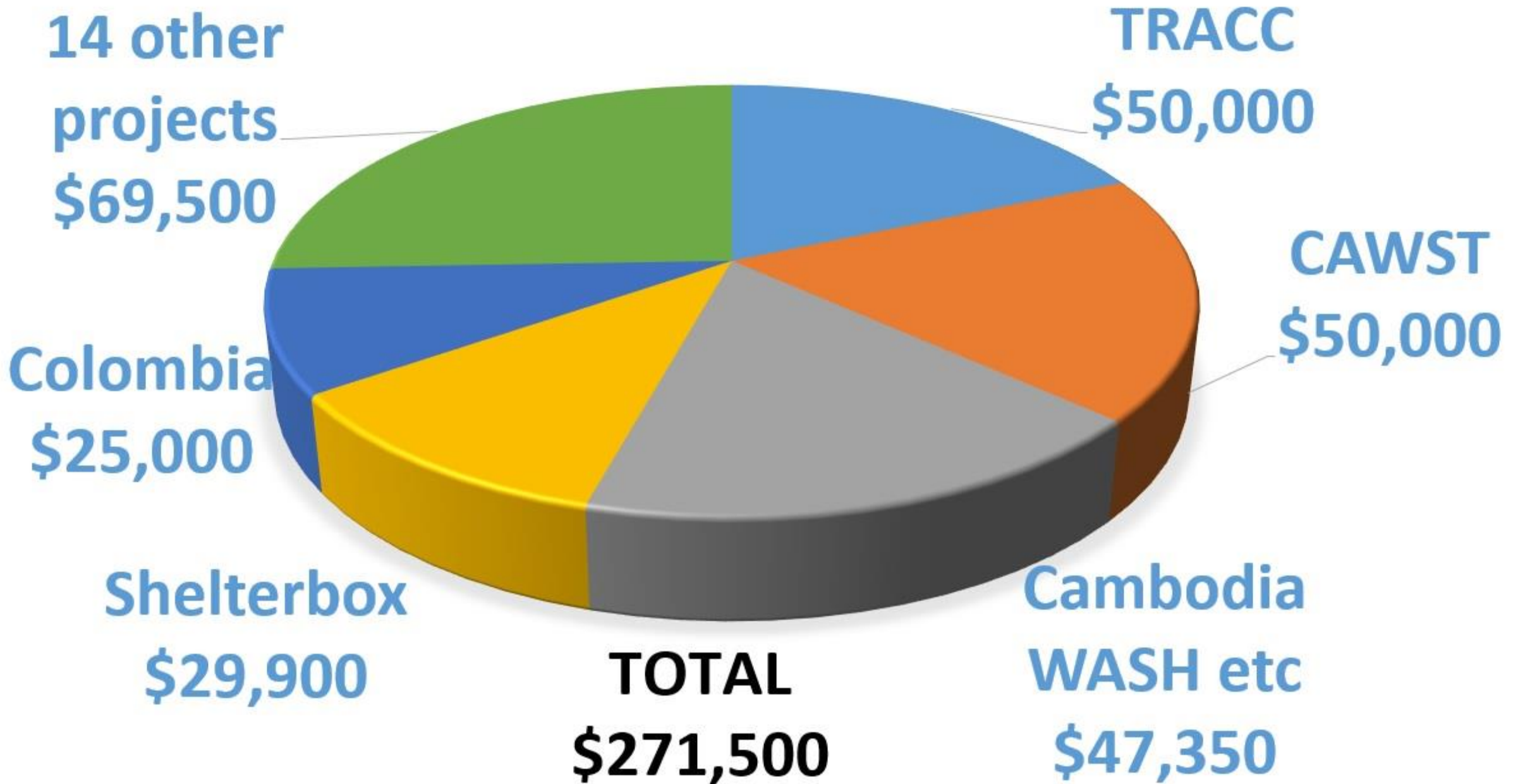

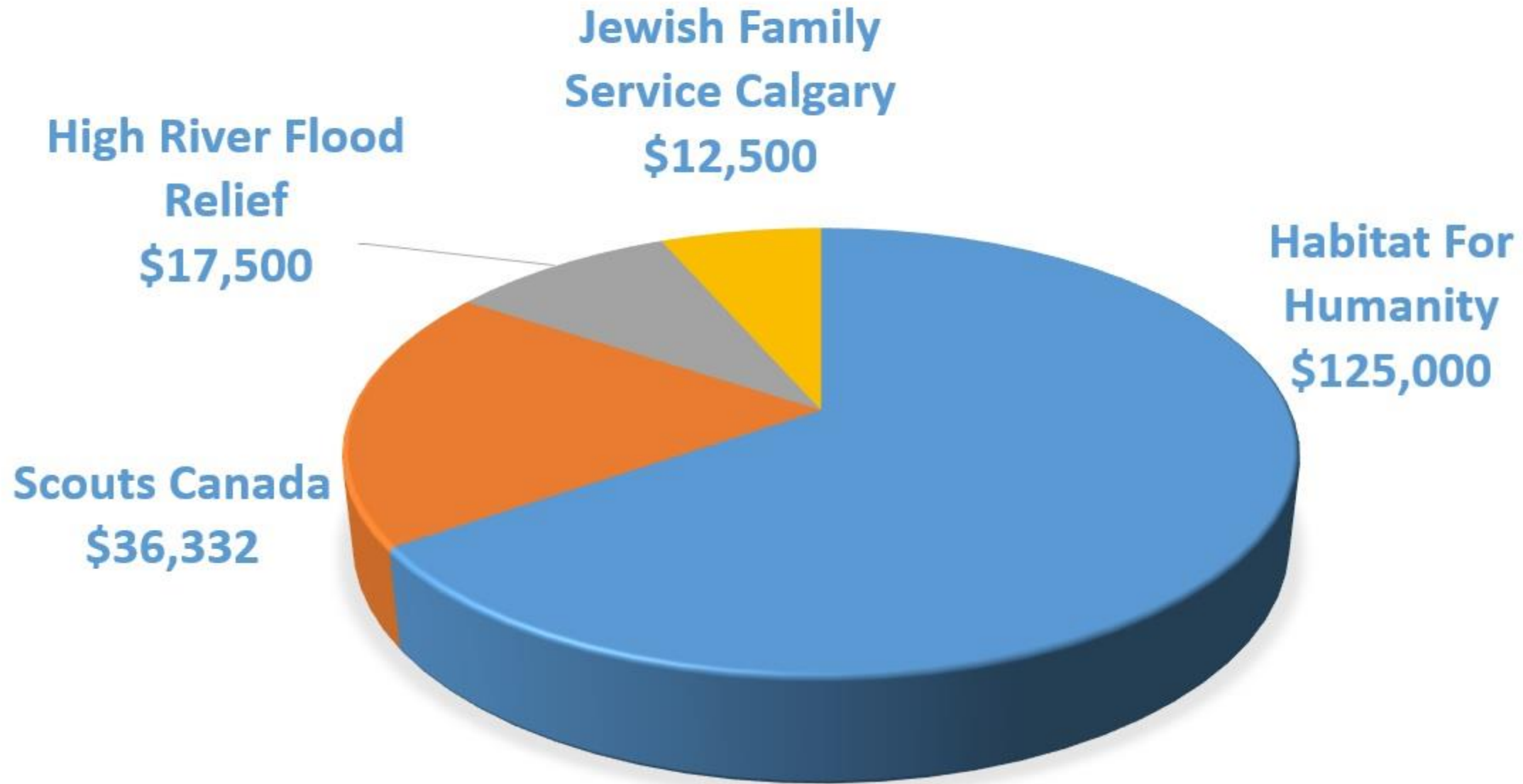

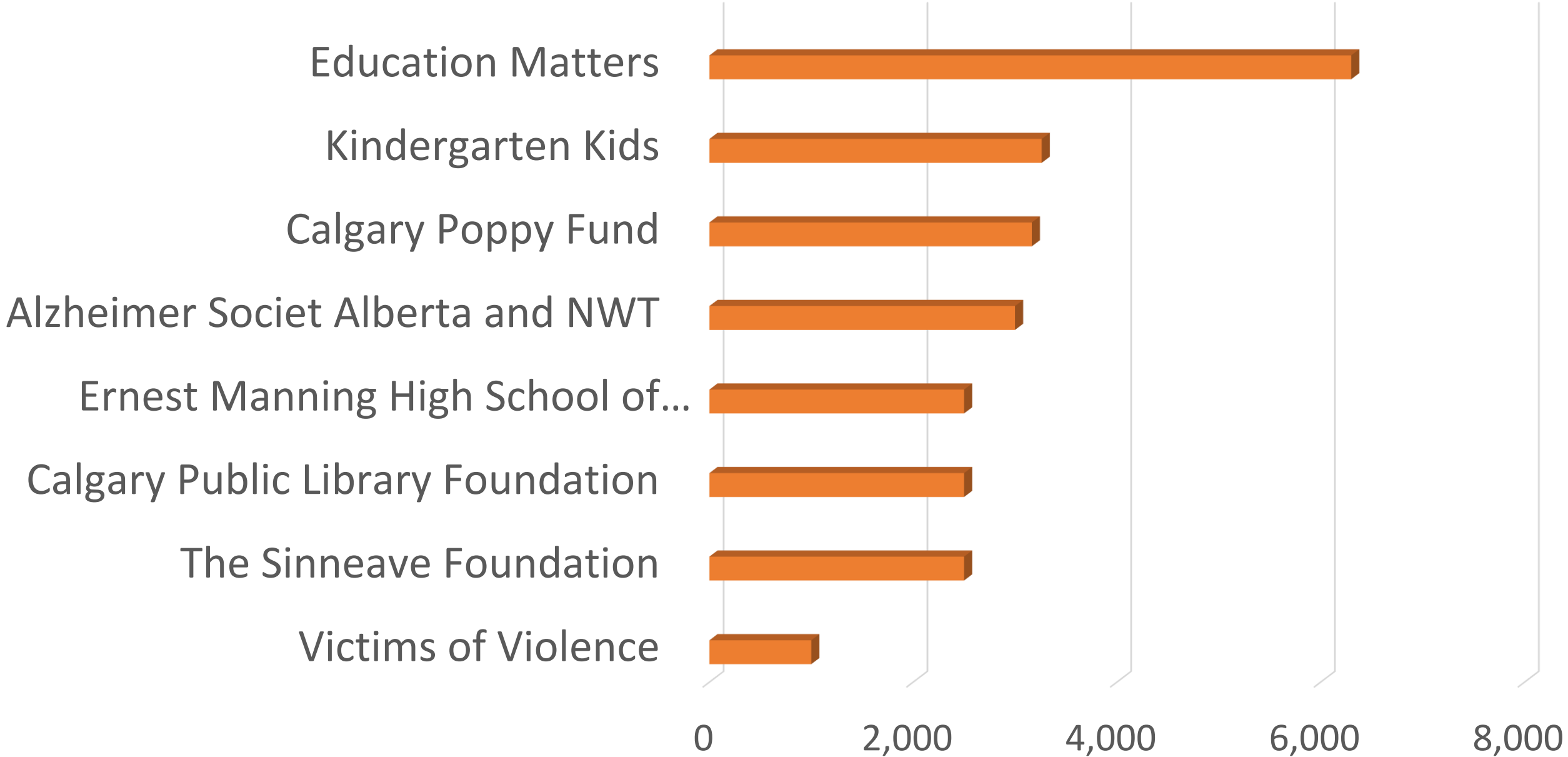
