Activities & Results continued...

TRF helps fund humanitarian activities from local projects to Global initiatives. TRF's Annual Fund is shared with District 5360 for use in District and Global Grants and RI will match the Global Grants dollar for dollar. In the Rotary Year 2013/2014, TRF awarded over 868 Global Grants contributing more than US\$47.4 million to support Rotarians' good works! One great example came in the case of disaster in Canada in June 2013. When catastrophic flooding hit Alberta, Canada, it displaced over 100,000 people and created more than US\$6 billion in damage to homes and businesses. Rotary Districts 6400 and 7500 used a global grant to respond to a natural disaster in a sustainable and long term way. US\$219,000 was given by over 175 Rotary clubs to provide bridge financing to help High River small businesses re-establish their businesses. Also, \$60,000 was used for a series of workshops and one-on-one coaching.

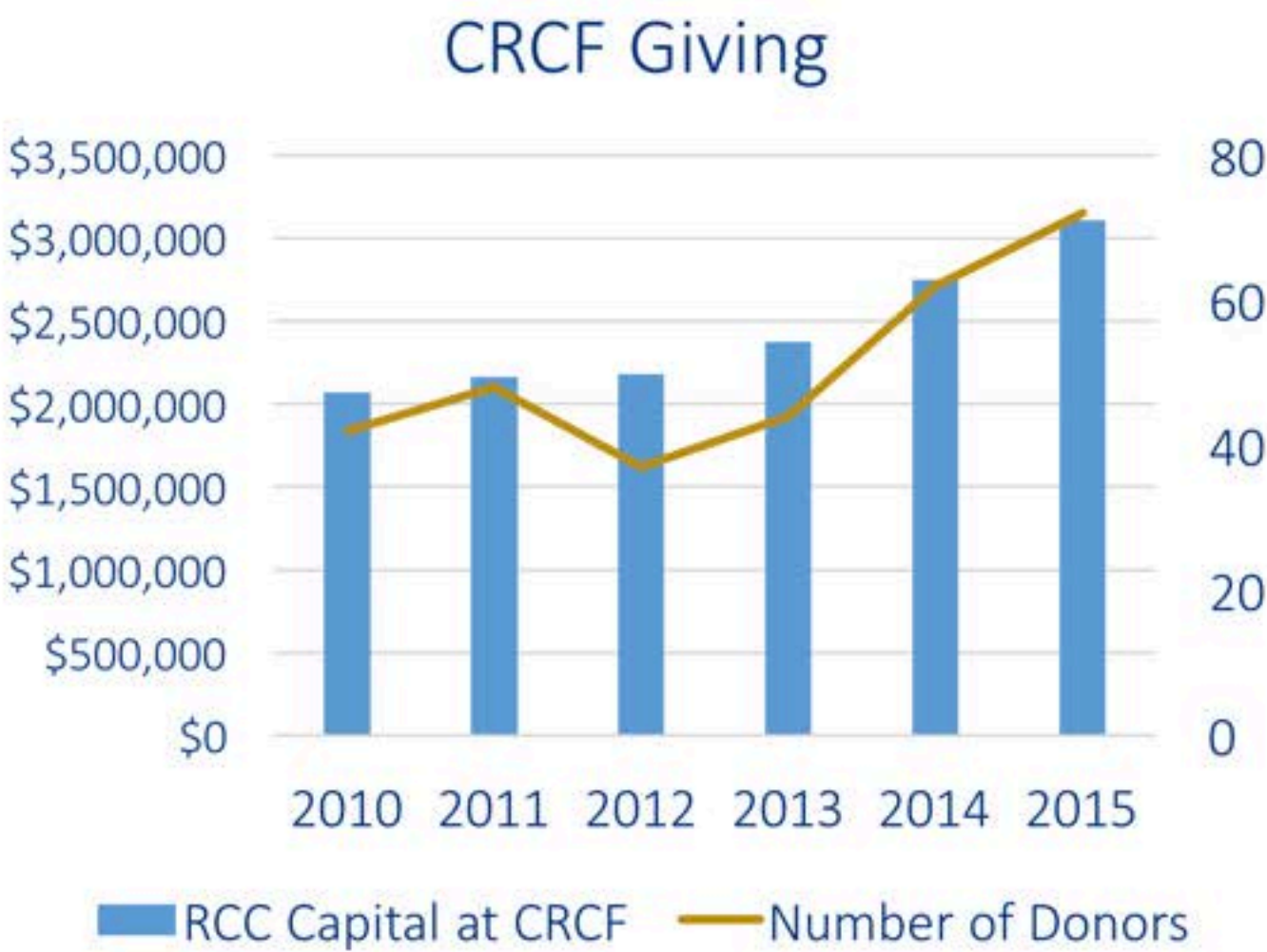


WHERE DOES OUR FUNDING COME FROM?

YOUR GIVING TO THE ROTARY FOUNDATION

- Between 35 and 45 RCC members make donations to TRF each year.
- 116 have made a TRF donation at some point in their Rotary career.
- 45% of our active members are Paul Harris Fellows.
- 2014-2015 has seen particularly strong support of the TRF Permanent Fund, Polio and Other Funds.

WHERE HAVE WE MADE MAJOR CONTRIBUTIONS?

- \$500,000 Legacy Gift for the Rotary Mattamy Greenway – a 138km network of parks and pathways that will encircle all of Calgary.

Plus major donations for this Rotary year:

- \$30,000 for the Elizabeth Fry Society to assist high risk female youth in the criminal justice system.
- \$75,000 to the Calgary Public Library for its "library month at your daycare" project- purchase of books.
- \$85,000 to The Nourish Network to establish a school network for 6 agencies to assist children.
- \$30,000 to the Association for the Rehabilitation of the Brain Injured to refurbish and furnish reconfigured space.
- \$30,000 to the Families Matter Society for the expansion of a family resource centre at Shaganappi Village.

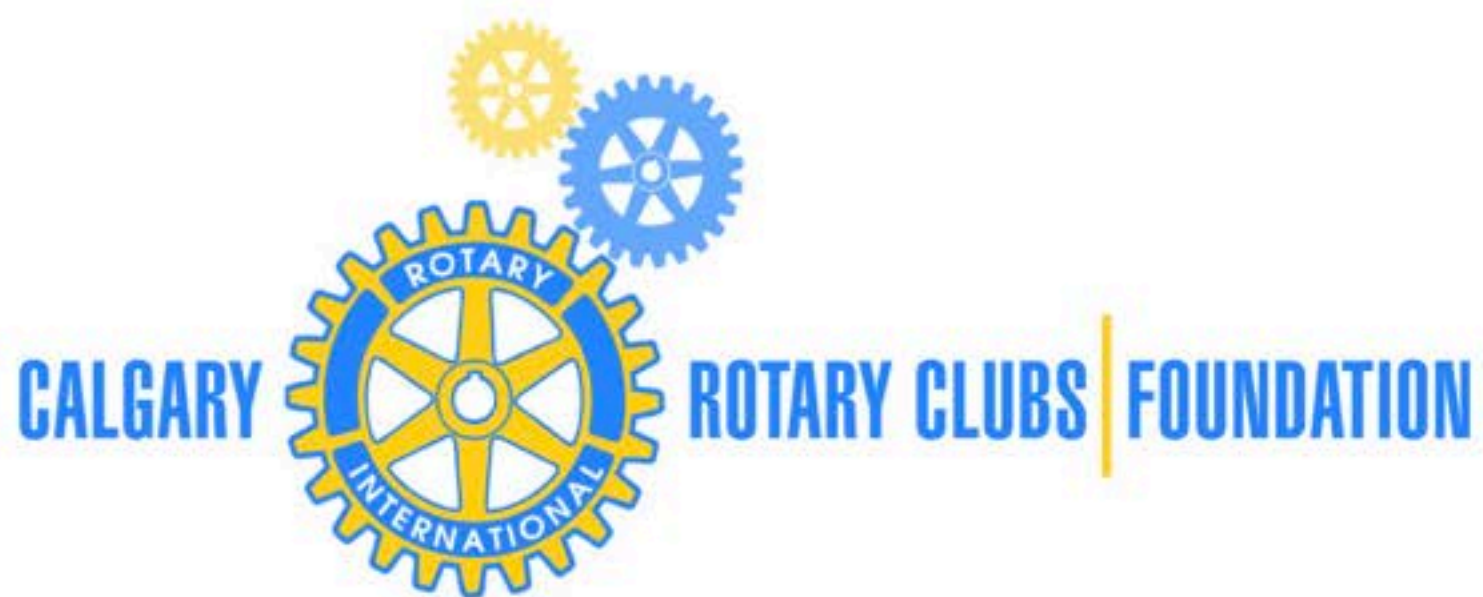
