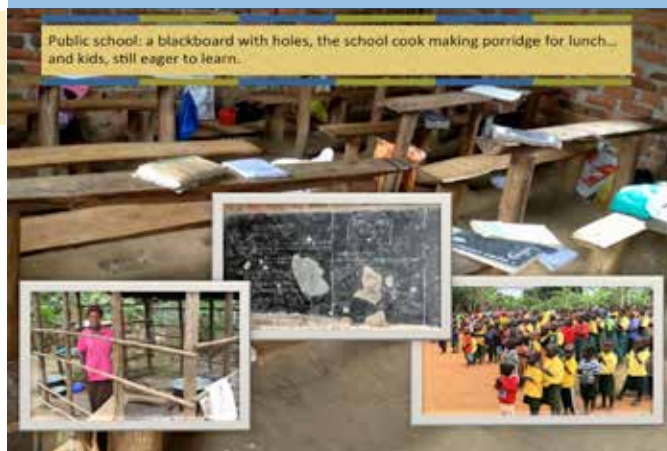

Ellen Mayhood 1913-2000

Everett Mayhood 1914-2005

Ev Mayhood was a committed Rotarian for 42 years, his wife Ellen at his side at most Rotary Club of Calgary events. Ev was a Paul Harris Fellow, the recipient of a Rotary International crystal, and an honorary life member of the Calgary Chamber of Commerce in recognition of his community service.

Ev and Ellen’s significant contributions to the Calgary Rotary Club Foundation began in 1990, and culminated with the bequest of \$30 million from their estate to the CRCF, the income from which is distributed equally for the benefit of The Rotary Club of Calgary and The Rotary Foundation of Rotary International.

The Mayhood Honour Roll is dedicated to their memory so that their extraordinary generosity, as well as the past and continuing generosity of many other Rotary Club of Calgary members, will be forever recognized and remembered.

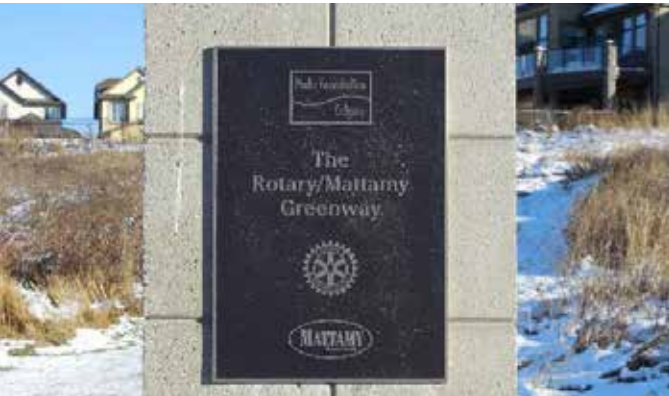
Two Foundations One Common Purpose
