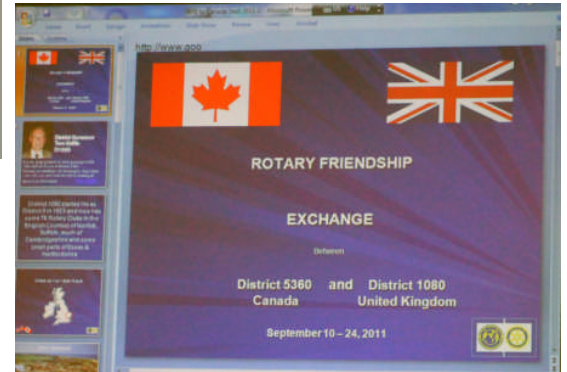

I have not experienced a "non typical" school day so I can't really answer that question. Umm, surviving without Spanish is easy because most people speak English, but I only speak English if I really need to. Gotta go, dad's gonna shut off the internet. Michael."

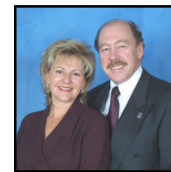
